

Invitation for the site visit of the WP2 project on 30 September 2011.

As foreseen in the AMICE project, we should visit our partners on location. This is the dreamed of opportunity for you to visit one of the Dutch investment. The Steenbergse Vliet project, known in AMICE as the action 16 in WP2.

The project is ready now and we invite you to visit the site and gain knowledge of the geographical situation, the approach, the backgrounds of the project, the involved parties and partners, the communities and people busy on the development of the project.

It will be a real outdoor day. We are going for a walk along the Steenbergse vliet over the project site towards the pumping station. So you certainly need good boots or appropriate walking shoes. As the project is just ready, we are walking on clay. When it is dry you can easily walk there, but with rainy weather it is really sticky. We will have a simple lunch in the open air. Afterwards (in order to digest the lunch) we are going for a cycle tour along the POI's (Points Of Interest) made for the project and the tourists. We are going in the direction of Benedensas, which is a 5 km cycle tour. Maybe it will rain and it surely will be windy in this open area. So please look at the weather forecast for that day and take good weather clothes with you. At Benedensas we will take the bus back to the city hall of Steenbergen, where your car can be parked during the day.

The aim of the day is to exchange knowledge and experience, develop knowledge of each project area in relation to the total Meuse basin. During the site visits the general AMICE message will be explained and will be promoted: "It is necessary to develop a "team spirit", an attitude of information sharing at a trans national level, between all operators on the Meuse basin in order to cope with the effects of climate changes." So you, as a partner, will have the opportunity to meet the others on-site and see the different sub-projects, which will be carried out within AMICE.
