So, also on behalf of the community of Hotton I'm so glad to invite you to have a new look around here! The site visit is planned on **June 21st**, so the weather should be fine.

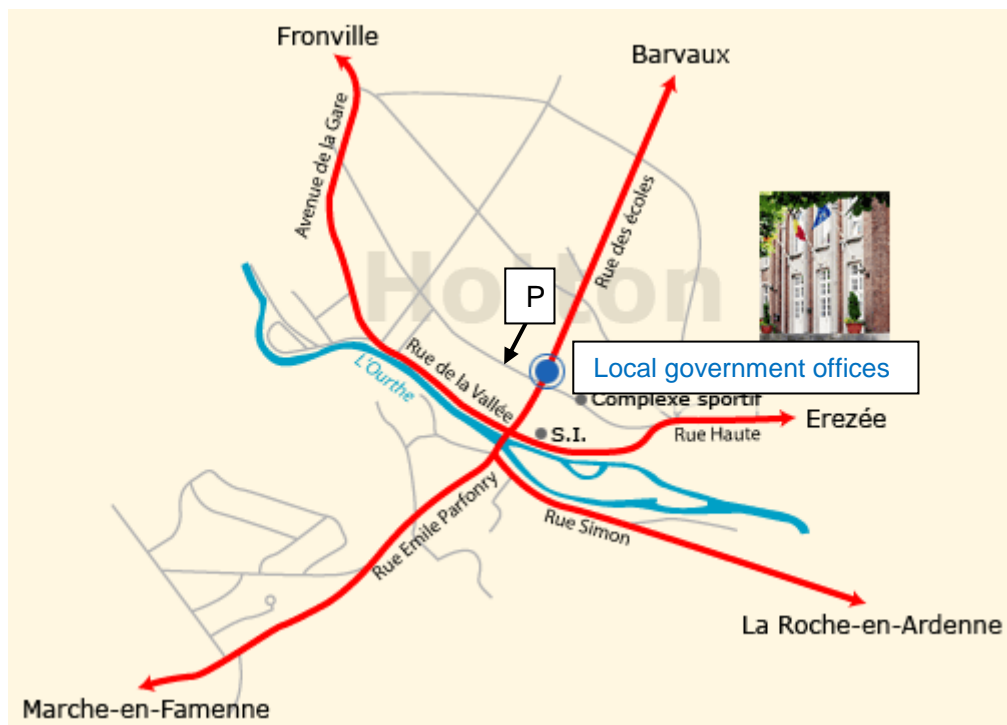
And this is the programme:

10.15 Introduction to the project and survey of what happens at Ny and the river Naives' floodplain;

11.00 Visit of the discovery centre RIVEO, 'the world of the river' at Hotton (more info: www.riveo.be);
12.30 Barbecue at Hotton;
14.00 Site visit: AMICE works on the river Naives and its floodplain;
15.00 Site visit: Rehabilitation of the village of Ny: walk around the village, its river and fountains; discovering what is being done in order to make it a yet more beautiful village;
15.50 Back to Hotton by bus or on foot (3 km) for those who prefer walking (after that barbecue!).
16.00 – 16.45 The end
